Weekend conditions of agreement and general information;

1. Dogs are welcome as long as they are controlled and don't disturb other campers. They are also required to be under the control of the owner at all times when inside your tent/ caravan or camper. In some instances we will request you to put your dog on a lead, please do not take offence this will be only requested if the organisers feel there may be a risk to other campers or dogs.
2. You are responsible for clearing up after your dog. Children are free to roam and play around the campsite and often don't look down to see where they are walking or falling.
3. There is a quiet period between 23.30- 08.00 and we kindly ask that noise is kept to a minimum during these times.
4. Any abusive behaviour towards anyone will not be tolerated and could result in you being asked to leave the site immediately with no refund. In serious instances the police will be called to deal with it.
5. There is a strict rule by the field owners that there be **no open fires or charcoal barbeques** other than the ones put on by the organisers. Anyone found ignoring this will be asked to extinguish it immediately and continued occurrences will result in you being asked to leave without a refund.
6. You are also responsible for taking any rubbish you have created with you when you leave the site.
7. The pitches are available from 09.00 on Friday 31st July.
8. The organisers have arranged for entertainment in the form of fun and games which any persons can join in with. Although every effort has been made to make them as safe as possible anyone taking part does so at their own risk. The fun and games will all be subject to the weather conditions at the planned times.
9. Some games may incur an additional charge to cover prizes and costs to put them on.
10. The water slide will only be open at certain times during each day and the organisers kindly ask that everyone stays off of it when not open for general use.
11. The organisers request that when anyone arrives on site they sign in before setting up. This is solely to prevent anyone erecting a tent or parking a caravan/ camper in the wrong place.
12. Each pitch is designed to have one vehicle parked in it so there may be requests for additional vehicles to be parked in another location on the site.
13. Toilets will be available for use but there will not be any showering areas or washing up facilities.
