Member's information, rules & code of practice for the 5th

1. Please wear suitable protective footwear & clothing as you will be on the streets for many hours in potentially wet/cold conditions. You should have sturdy footwear – **NO** trainers are permitted.
2. We are very proud of our traditions and encourage all members to dress as either, a 1st Pioneer, 2nd Pioneer, Clergy or as a Smuggler, (knitted jersey & white full length trousers), or as any other fancy dress. The dress of 1st & 2nd pioneers of other societies is not permitted and you will be refused entry to the processions. It is also unacceptable to wear society merchandise such as t-shirts, hoodies, etc. **Please remember, if a smuggler, you are a worker of the society and if we are short of help we will take smugglers out of ranks to assist.**
3. All members must wear their membership badge as proof of membership.
4. Please follow all instructions given by Police Liaison Officers, Commander-in-Chief, Aide-de-Camp, Captain of Ranks or any of the marshals.
5. If you see something that concerns you, please bring it to the attention of the marshals who will let the appropriate people know and take the appropriate action.
6. The bonfire tradition goes back centuries and part of that includes aerial fireworks. You may wish to use eye & ear protection, especially for younger members.
7. **All dropdowns/rookies are illegal. Members risk expulsion from the procession if they use them.**
8. Please maintain a respectful silence at the War Memorial on the 1st procession.
9. Please respect the various traditions at Bonfire Prayers. If you are in any doubt as to what is acceptable behaviour then ask or take your lead from the marshals.

We would really appreciate any help that you can provide on the morning of the 6th tidying up the fire site. Just turn up from 7am onwards. Our society cannot afford to lose our deposit if the site is not clear enough.
